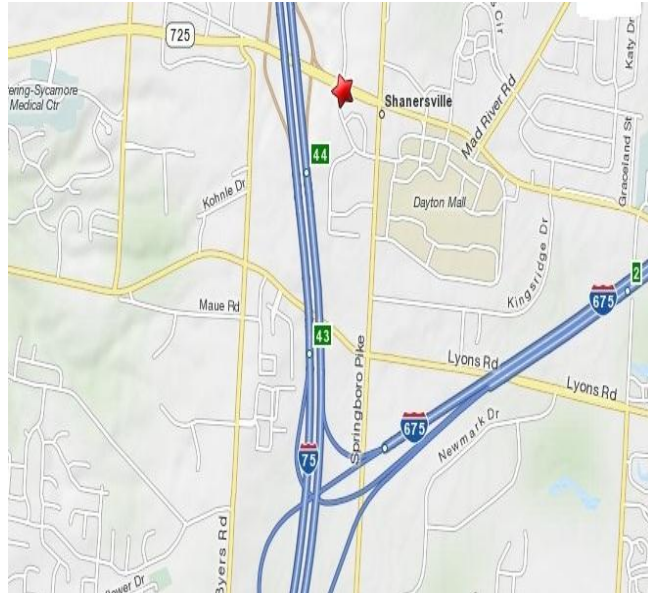
Directions to the hotel:
